



**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE  
WHEELING POLICE PENSION FUND BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
FEBRUARY 5, 2021**



A special meeting of the Wheeling Police Pension Fund Board of Trustees was held on Thursday, February 5, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. in the Wheeling Village Hall Council Chambers located at 2 Community Blvd., Wheeling, Illinois 60090, via videoconference and in-person in accordance with guidance issued by the Illinois Attorney General's Office and Public Act 101-0640, pursuant to notice.

**1. CALL TO ORDER:** Trustee Musolf called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

**3. STEPHEN HULL DISABILITY PENSION HEARING – The Pension Board will take evidence and hear arguments with respect to the pension claim, adjudicate any petitions/motions with respect to the pension claim, and may take action to adjudicate the pension claim.**

Pension Board Exhibits 1 through 41, Applicant Exhibits 1 through 3, and Village Exhibits 1 through 5 were admitted into evidence without objection. The Pension Board heard testimony from the following witnesses: Nicole Hull, Stephen Hull, and Police Chief James Dunne.
