### What to Expect

- ◆ Construction to begin mid to late May, 2017 and conclude by late August 2017.
- ◆ Daily work hours— Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and if necessary 7:00 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
- ◆ Temporary driveway access interruptions may be experienced, however, prior notifications will be made.
- ◆ In most cases streets will be open for evening and night parking in those areas where it is normally allowed.
- ◆ During construction, street parking will be allowed per posted signs.
- ◆ Dust control measures will be implemented and monitored.
- ◆ **This type of work involves the operation of equipment and heavy machinery. Please exercise caution and avoid the construction zone.**

### Special Notice to Owners of Underground Lawn Sprinkler Systems Located in the Village

It is the property owner's responsibility to arrange for the repair and bear the cost of any lawn sprinkler system and/or piping within the public right-of-way that gets damaged by the contractor. It is recommended that any sprinkler system within the public right-of-way be relocated prior to curb removal. During the various phases of construction, we also request that no lawn sprinkling adjacent to these ongoing improvements takes place.
