


Greetings from Wheeling, Illinois



WHAT IS SPECIAL ABOUT WHEELING, ILLINOIS?

- Wheeling is an international gateway with Chicago Executive Airport and is only 8 miles from Chicago O'Hare International Airport.
- The Korean Cultural Center of Chicago is headquartered in Wheeling.
- The tenth congressional district including Wheeling is the fourth largest manufacturing concentration in the United States.
- Wheeling contains nearly 14 million square feet of manufacturing space.
- Wheeling is a restaurant destination with world-class dining with an eclectic mix of 22 restaurants from casual to fine dining.
- The finest dining in the northern suburbs is found on Wheeling's Restaurant Row located along the Des Plaines River.
- The Westin Chicago North Shore Hotel & Convention Center in Wheeling contains 412 rooms and 30,000 square feet of banquet space.




Located in the Midwest region of the United States, Wheeling is a city in Illinois located near Chicago's O'Hare International Airport and an hour drive from the City Center of the City of Chicago. WHEELING - ON CHICAGO'S NORTH SHORE



Wheeling is located on the North Shore area of the City of Chicago along beautiful Lake Michigan. This area is the most picturesque region in the metropolitan Chicago area boasting a scenic byway along the lakefront rich in natural beauty and homes and gardens of distinction. Nearby, it is very easy to visit some of these popular attractions: **Northwestern University, Chicago Botanic Garden**, the only **Baha'i House of Worship** in the United States, **Ravinia Festival**, the **North Shore Center for Performing Arts in Skokie** and many elegant shopping centers including **Northbrook Court, Westfield Old Orchard** and the **Glen Town Center**.



CITY OF CHICAGO



Chicago is the third most populous city in the United States. With over 2.7 million residents, it is the most populous city in the state of Illinois and the Midwest. The Chicago metropolitan area is home to nearly 10 million people.

Chicago was incorporated as a city in 1837 and today the city is an international hub for finance, commerce, industry, technology, telecommunications, and transportation, with O'Hare International Airport being the busiest airport in the world; it also has the largest number of U.S. highways and railroad freight.

In 2014, Chicago hosted 50.2 million international and domestic visitors. Chicago's culture includes contributions to the visual arts, novels, film, theater, especially improvisational comedy, and music, particularly jazz, blues, and soul.
