The Village of Wheeling and Solid Waste of Agency of Northern Cook County (SWANCC) are hosting a document destruction and electronics recycling event. Residents from Wheeling and other SWANCC communities are eligible to participate. Materials *will not* be collected from businesses, schools, institutions or non-SWANCC residents. **Photo IDs with addresses will be checked for verification of residency. Non-SWANCC community residents will be re-directed to an exit.**

Due to safety, amount of vehicles and space constraints, residents will not be allowed to exit their vehicles at any time for any reason or park. Residents should expect delays, or longer waiting times, during this event. It is recommended to arrive no later than 11:00 am to ensure participation.

Document/Shredding Requirements

- Includes medical records/forms, tax forms, bank statements, personal documents.
- No magazines, newspapers, greeting cards, photos., folders, plastic sleeves.
- Metal clips and binders must be removed.
- Limit of six (6) file-size boxes or paper bags per vehicle. Boxes will be returned to the resident once emptied. No plastic bags.



Acceptable Electronics

Non—Acceptable Items

stereo, speakers, batteries or battery back-up, air conditioner, dehumidifier, humidifier, home appliances, lamps, microwaves, vacuum cleaners, refrigerators, large home appliances, CD/DVD or VHS.
