

**Day 2 Vaccination Dose

The Village of Wheeling would like to remind participants that if they received a first dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine at the March 17 mass vaccination event at the Schaumburg Convention Center, they are expected to come back to receive their second dose of the vaccine on Wednesday, April 7 at the convention center.

Participants' appointments for their second shot are at the same time they received their first shot on March 17. There is no need to register again to receive the second shot.

This clinic is only for individuals who received their first vaccine shot on March 17 at the Schaumburg Convention Center.

**What to Bring:**

- CDC Vaccine Card that was provided on March 17
- Completed Consent Form
- Valid ID (driver's license or State ID card)
- Medical/prescription insurance card

**If you fail to bring these items to show proof of receiving the first vaccine shot on March 17 at the Schaumburg Convention Center, you may be turned away.** Please remember to have these items with you during check-in. Although consent forms will be available onsite for those who are unable to bring them, having all the necessary items will ensure individuals will move through the process quickly to reduce wait times.

Please wear a short-sleeved shirt or other clothing that will allow easy access to the upper arm for the vaccination, as no private changing areas will be available.
